Larson & Darby Group Awarded Design of New Cherry Valley Public Works Facility

Rockford, IL. (October 27, 2014) – Larson & Darby Group has been awarded and has begun construction on a new public works facility for the Village of Cherry Valley off of Van Diver Road. The site, a well-designed, efficient and high quality facility, is to include a trailhead pavilion area and parking for the Swanson bike path. Specific landscape and plantings will be implemented to restore it to a native prairie palette.

The main facility is 16,600 square feet of which 14,400 square feet is the main public works garage and maintenance area. It contains 18 vehicle parking spaces as well as a wash bay, large rack storage area, a vehicle maintenance bay, small tool storage and a sign shop. The office portion of the building includes two offices, a map/work room, a training/break room, locker rooms and restrooms along with other general operation spaces. In addition to the main facility, there is an adjacent set of structures that will include a large salt storage building and various material storage areas, some of which will also be covered.
